

## MINISTER TO OVER 2,500 KIDS A YEAR!

Summit's Fellowship Program is more than a job – it's a passion for sharing the Gospel and an opportunity to get equipped for future ministry. Each Summit Fellow will go on around 30-35 camps per year and will share the message of Jesus with around 2,500 campers! Each camp is between two days and one week in length.

Because the Gospel is shared on every camp, it's not only a training program – it's a missionary role, sharing the Gospel with kids who haven't heard it before. Summit provides you with on-the-job ministry training as you evangelise 8-18 year olds. Plus, when not on camp, you will benefit from training in a wide range of ministry and outdoor recreation skills.

## EARN WHILE YOU LEARN

No fees! Summit will pay you a fortnightly allowance and won't charge you for all the tuition and training you receive. All accommodation and food while on camp is also provided for free.

## 24/7 MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES

This role is not for the faint hearted. Being a Summit Fellow means evangelising a tough audience – kids! But it's definitely worth it! Camping ministry is unique in that it's residential, meaning there are countless opportunities to spend time building relationships with students, talking to them about Christianity and modelling Christian living 24/7.

You will get to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ with heaps of schools students every day – students from a wide range of backgrounds, family situations and religions. On every Summit Camp, a daily Bible talk is given and you will be trained to lead small group discussion and answer tricky apologetics questions.

## NOT JUST A QUALIFICATION

The Summit Fellowship is a two year, full-time training and ministry program. Upon completion of the course you will have received:

- A range of formal qualifications, including:
  - Nationally recognised Certificates II and III in Outdoor Recreation;
  - Units of the Moore College Preliminary Theological Certificate (PTC);
  - Senior First Aid & Bronze Medallion.
- Informal qualifications: skills in up front leading, Bible teaching, small group discussion, presenting, engaging communication techniques, planning and organisation;
- Qualifications in activities like canoeing, abseiling, sailing, archery, rock climbing, high ropes and bushwalking;
- Heaps of hands on experience leading and directing Crusaders' Summit & CRU Holiday Camps;
- The potential to continue for a further two years in a senior ministry training role, extending your training and upgrading your qualifications.

Summit has been a division of the Crusader Union of Australia since 1988. Crusaders is an interdenominational, Christian youth organisation that seeks to reach school students with the life-changing Gospel of Jesus Christ through camping and schools ministry. Summit's focus is school camps.
