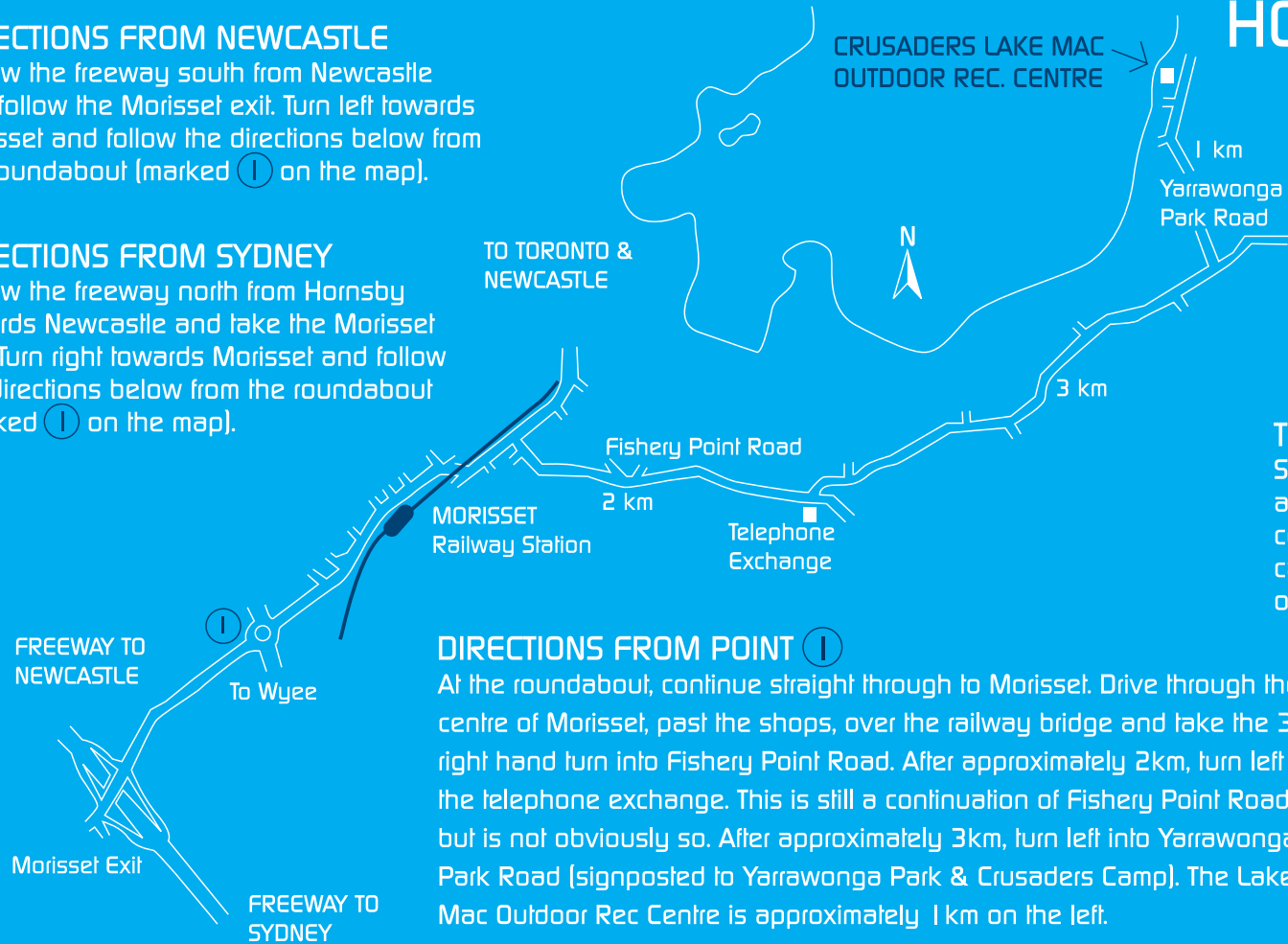

DIRECTIONS FROM NEWCASTLE

Follow the freeway south from Newcastle and follow the Morisset exit. Turn left towards Morisset and follow the directions below from the roundabout (marked ① on the map).

DIRECTIONS FROM SYDNEY

Follow the freeway north from Hornsby towards Newcastle and take the Morisset exit. Turn right towards Morisset and follow the directions below from the roundabout (marked ① on the map).



HOW DO WE GET THERE?

TRAVELING BY TRAIN

Some fare concessions may be allowed to persons arriving at Wyee Railway Station. A reasonably priced connecting bus to/from Wyee or Morisset Railway Station can be arranged by phoning the Toronto Bus Service on (02) 4959 1233.

DIRECTIONS FROM POINT ①

At the roundabout, continue straight through to Morisset. Drive through the centre of Morisset, past the shops, over the railway bridge and take the 3rd right hand turn into Fishery Point Road. After approximately 2km, turn left at the telephone exchange. This is still a continuation of Fishery Point Road but is not obviously so. After approximately 3km, turn left into Yarrowonga Park Road (signposted to Yarrowonga Park & Crusaders Camp). The Lake Mac Outdoor Rec Centre is approximately 1 km on the left.
