Before You Start

- · Please note that all pages in this resource can be photocopied but CRU requests each school or church purchase at least one original.
- · Whilst this resource is aimed at easing the load for the group leader, it is vital that time is spent adapting it to the specific needs of your group. Time also needs to be spent on working through the Bible passage and questions before the group meets.
- A variety of video clips and other resources (including PowerPoint slides with the Bible verses for each week) are used in this series. All resources, including video clips, should be checked before the meeting to make sure they are appropriate for your group and there are no technical problems. - · It would be very easy to spend too much time on the activity each week. Remember that looking at the Bible and praying together are the most important parts of the meeting, so divide your time accordingly.
- All games, activities and illustrations should be evaluated to make sure they can be safely done for your group. This will include considering safety in physical and food games, and appropriate illustrations considering the maturity level of your groups.

Week 1 So Many Blessings

Ephesians 1:3-4, 7-8, 14

Lesson Aim:
For students to be amazed at all that God has done, is doing, and will do for those who trust in Him.

Prepare

- Pray that the students would be excited about the spiritual blessings God offers to them.
- Read through Ephesians 1:3–14, familiarising yourself with the passage.
- Ensure you have the facilities to show the optional Web Extras infants' song, and PowerPoints for the Bible Reading and Memory Verse.
- A small, wrapped gift box for the Activity.
- Print the optional Web Extras infants craft 'God Chose You'.

Activity: The Secret Gift

5 minutes

Using the small, wrapped present you've made from the prepare section, arrange for all the students to stand in a circle, facing each other. Their goal is to pass the gift around behind their backs, while one student in the middle of the circle has to guess who is currently holding it. If you have a large group, you may wish to form two or more games (and wrapped gifts) going on at once.



Bible Time

7 minutes

? What is the top present you've ever received, or you could ever receive, at Christmas or on your birthday? [Allow responses]

Today we're going to start looking at a book in the Bible called Ephesians. It begins by telling us about some even more amazing gifts that God gives to His followers — gifts that we really need and that last forever!

Using the Web Extras Weekly Bible Verses
PowerPoint (the animated treasure chest
section), go through each of the three blessings
it lists and talk about each one below.

There are so many blessings that God gives to those who follow Jesus, but for today we're going to focus mainly on three.

The first gift God gives is being **chosen in Christ**. It's nice when someone gets you a surprise present for no reason. It shows that they are thinking about you and that they care. In the same way, before the world even began, God in His kindness chose us to be in His family even though we didn't deserve it. Jesus is God's ultimate surprise gift!

And with this gift also comes this — we are **saved from sin's penalty**. Because God sent Jesus to die on the cross, our sins are now forgiven. We get to start a new life forgiven and free today despite all our mistakes!

That's already so amazing, but there's even more! Because God chose us and sent Jesus to save us, we will be given an **eternal inheritance** — life forever in God's kingdom. That's better than any earthly present we could get at Christmas or on our birthday, because none of them will last forever.

Application

8 minutes



? 1. Which one of God's gifts are you most excited about at the moment, and why? [Allow a few responses]

All of them are really amazing and exciting! They all last forever (unlike many other gifts we get in life) and are exactly what every person needs to have the fullest and best life ever. And these blessings (plus many more) are for anyone who wishes to have them. Would you like to have all of these spiritual blessings today and forever? Then trust in and follow Jesus — since they all come from Him.

? 2. According to verse 14, what should we say to God for the gifts He gives us? What should we also do?

Display the Web Extras Weekly PowerPoint verses, and allow responses.

What do we say to anyone who gives us a gift? We say "thank you". In fact, today's Bible verse (verse 14) also tells us that God should be honoured and praised for all His blessings. We can do this with our words, but also with our actions. With our actions we can trust and follow Jesus. We can obey the things He says in the Bible. We can also remember all the things God has given us and live gratefully each day — all as a way of saying thank you to God for lavishing us with these amazing, everlasting gifts.

Introduce and go through the series' memory verse in the Web Extras PowerPoint 'Memory Verse'. Arrange to use this memory verse weekby-week.

5 minutes

Craft: God Chose You

Complete the **God Chose You** colouring in Web Extras sheet with any infants if you feel this would be appropriate for your group.

Song Idea

Invite three students to give thanks and praise to God for each of the three blessings that were looked at today. Close with a prayer that asks God to help the students to live thankfully.


