Before You Start

- Please note that all pages in this resource can be photocopied but CRU requests each school or church purchase at least one original.
- Whilst this resource is aimed at easing the load for the group leader, it is vital that time is spent adapting it to the specific needs of your group. Time also needs to be spent on working through the Bible passage and questions before the group meets.
- A variety of video clips and other resources (including PowerPoint slides with the Bible verses for each
 week) are used in this series. All resources, including video clips, should be checked before the meeting to
 make sure they are appropriate for your group and there are no technical problems. The resources can be
 accessed from the Web Extras section of the CRU website: www.cru.edu.au/webextras
- It would be very easy to spend too much time on the activity each week. Remember that looking at the Bible and praying together are the most important parts of the meeting, so divide your time accordingly.
- All games, activities and illustrations should be evaluated to make sure they can be safely done for your group. This will include considering safety in physical and food games, and appropriate illustrations considering the maturity level of your group.
- Note: Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people should be aware that this resource contains names
 of people who have (or may have) since passed away.

Week	Title	Passages	Main Idea
1	Countless Blessings	Ephesians 1:3-14	Through Jesus, God has lavished us with every spiritual thing we need.
2	Brought Back From The Dead Outreach Week	Ephesians 2:1-5	Jesus brings dead people back to life.
3	Only By Grace	Ephesians 2:8-10	Eternal life through Jesus is God's gift – not something we can ever earn.
4	Powerful God, Powerful Prayer	Ephesians 3:14-21	Our loving God is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine.
5	A New Way To Live	Ephesians 4:1-6, 4:25-32	Jesus' followers imitate Him by treating others well.
6	Gifts That Keep On Giving	Ephesians 4:11-16	Christ gives each of His followers gifts to serve God and others.

Week 1 Countless Blessings

Ephesians 1:3-14

Aim:
For students to be amazed at all that God has done, is doing, and will do for those who trust in Him.

Prepare

- Pray that the students would recognise and be thankful for all the spiritual blessings God gives.
- Read through the above Bible passage, familiarising yourself with its context and content.
- Photocopy the Week 1 Students' page for everyone (p.24).
- Ensure you have the facilities to show the Web Extras PowerPoint 'Weekly Bible Verses and Headings', and the Web Extras video 'You Say'.
- Print out the Web Extras 'I Am cards' and 'Outreach Invitations'. Plan to ask students to invite their friends to next week's Outreach Week.
- For the activity, bring a gift box and various objects to be placed in it (e.g. a ball, pen, banana, clip, coin, etc.)

Activity: What's In The Box?

6 minutes


In this up-front game, invite students to guess what object is inside a gift box. Students cannot open the box and look in it, but can shake it, hear it, and feel the weight. Allow multiple guesses before revealing the correct answer. Put a new object in it for each subsequent round. Plan to link this when you talk about the gift discussion in question 1.

Intro: The Book of Ephesians

1 minute

If you're a follower of Jesus, you are rich beyond measure. It's true! You may not have realised it yet. A bit like if a bird found a hole in the roof of a bank and was taking off with bank notes to build its nest – they'd be sitting on wealth without even realising it. Well, over the next nine weeks, we're going to be looking at the New Testament book of Ephesians, and it's going to reveal all the riches and blessings God has given His people through Jesus, and what that means for how we should live today. It's going to be amazing and life-changing!

Pray with the students, giving thanks to God for speaking through the book of Ephesians, and pray that the students would be amazed by what He reveals.



Discuss

15 minutes

? 1. What are the top three gifts you've ever received at Christmas or on your birthdays? What do you think is the best gift you could ever get?

As great as some of these gifts may be, in many cases they're probably not the things we need the most in life. Nor might they be things that last a long time. This means that, ultimately, they won't bring true and lasting joy.

The start of Ephesians tells us that God has something even better for His followers. Gifts for them that truly satisfy because they are exactly what we need. Plus, these things last forever. As we read through Ephesians 1:3–14, see if you can find all the things that God has done and will do for His followers.

→ Have a student read out Ephesians 1:3-14 (ESV) from the 'Weekly Bible Verses & Headings' on screen.

? 2. In small groups, list all the things God has done and will do for His followers in Ephesians 1:3–14. Share answers afterwards.

Using the table and Bible verses on the students' page or PowerPoint, encourage students to fill in the missing 'Blessing' and 'What's said about the blessing' columns (answers given below).

Blessing	What's said about the blessing	
v.4 Chosen in Christ	God's choosing of us happened before the world was made - before we had done anything. The purpose behind it: for us to be holy and blameless (clean of sin).	
v.5-6 Adopted into God's family	God's choosing to adopt us happened because of God's free and unconditional love. We now have a permanent place in God's family.	
v.7–8 Redemption	To be redeemed is to be set free from something. In this case, Jesus' payment of His own blood redeems us from the penalty of sin. It's an extravagant gift from God.	
v.9–10 Knowledge of God's will	God doesn't leave us in the dark, but helps us to understand truth and reality as it really is - especially about His plans for us and the world through Jesus.	
v.11 Inheritance	As God's adopted children, we stand to receive all the eternal benefits that come from being in His family.	
v.13-14 Guarantee through the Holy Spirit	Nothing can take away our future inheritance. The Holy Spirit - God's presence within us - seals all this as the first taste of our inheritance.

Pray


3 minutes

Pause for a moment and, with the students in their small groups, spend some time simply thanking God for all the countless blessings we have been given through Jesus.

? 3. When do you find it difficult to praise or thank God? How do these verses help you to do those things?

Truly we are loved by God and rich beyond measure! The things that we truly need, God abundantly gives to those who trust in Jesus. Perhaps one of the reasons we often struggle to praise or thank God daily is because we forget or don't think much about all that God has done, is doing, and will do for us. But these verses from today's passage are a great reminder that should move us to praise and thank God - "to the praise of His glorious grace" (verse 6).

As you finish with the students, play the rest of the 'You Say' video. Hand out to any interested students the Web Extras 'I Am cards' so they can be reminded each day of God's blessings. Also hand out the Outreach Week invitations so students can invite friends to next week.
